in December 2019, I have asked the German Ministry of Justice and Consumer Protection ("BMJV") about the voting results on the judicial salaries of the UPC judges in the UPC Preparatory Committee meeting on 24/25 February 2016, based on the German Federal Freedom of Information Act.

The BMJV indicated to have obtained from the UPC Secretariat the information that in said vote, 19 Member States voted in favor of the proposal, one against it (France), two absented (Italy and Greece) and three did not attend. Could you please tell me which three Member States did not attend said vote?
