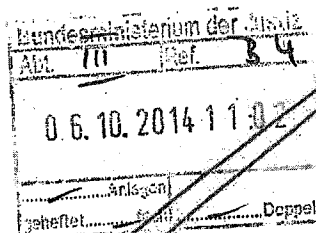

Dear Mrs. Labrou,

Mrs. Pakuscher asked me to contact You regarding your enquiry as to a German impact assessment study.

Well, we do not have a specific document "impact assessment study", I could send to you. The statute for the German ratification of the agreement is still in preparation, so I cannot provide you with that, either.

Preparing the ratification of the UPC Agreement the Federal Ministry of Justice and for Consumer Protection has established a Project Group which is in charge of preparing the ratification of the UPC Agreement. This Group is trying to assess the possible amount of the special financial contributions the Federal Republic of Germany will have to remit to balance the Court's budget. For that purpose, the discussion within the Finance Group of the Preparatory Committee is being followed closely, knowing that there will be no certainty, until the Budget Committee will finally have adopted the budget. Since it is work in progress and since there is not an official document yet, I would like to ask you to contact Coordinator of the Finance Group, Mr. J.F. Magana ([REDACTED]) for further questions.

In addition, the Project Group is evaluating the costs for providing the necessary facilities for setting up both the Munich section of the central division and the four local divisions of the UPC in Munich, Mannheim, Düsseldorf and Hamburg. Furthermore, the Project Group is assessing the costs for providing the administrative support staff during the initial transitional period of seven years. This work is done within the Federal Ministry of Justice and for Consumer Protection with the support of those states (Länder) hosting one of the four local divisions. The preparations have started, but have not been finalized. There is not too much information ready to be shared, since it is also work in progress. Nevertheless, you could give me a call and I could tell you a little more, if you want.

Other than that, the Project Group is not engaged and is currently not planning to engage, as far as the ratification is concerned, in further evaluations of the possible economic impact of establishing the UPC.
